Gamesmanship is an important part of soccer. Points can be deducted for unsportsmanlike behavior by players, coaches or fans. All points deducted will be done by a vote of the Board of Directors. (this will be based on an incidents reported to any staff or board member).

It is up to the team to make sure that the form is filled out and returned in time. No late forms will be accepted. (must be turned in prior to the start of the 13th game (which should be first week of May)

All eligible players will receive an award provided by the Region at no cost to the team or player.

Team Sportsmanship Award

Any team U7 and above may submit this form. Every team that is eligible will receive special recognition (medals, trophy or other similar recognition) for all players.

Total will be for first 12 weeks of season. (allows for time to order and deliver awards before end of season)

Teams must earn at least 100 points for the team to be eligible.

Point Details

Team Points – Points only awarded once during the season

- Trained Coach 5pts
Must complete the Coach training or provide proof that you have completed it within the last 3 years. Must hold certification and be in eAYSO as a documented Coach. Persons transferring or new to the region may apply for a waiver if proof of training is provided. Speak with the Chief Coach for waiver. Also must have Safe Haven certification for current year.
- Trained Asst Coach 5pts
Must complete the Coach training or provide proof that you have completed it within the last 3 years. Must hold certification and be in eAYSO as a documented Coach. Persons transferring or new to the region may apply for a waiver if proof of training is provided. Speak with the Chief Coach for waiver. Also must have Safe Haven certification for current year.
- Trained Ref 5pts
Must complete the Referee training or provide proof that you have completed it within the last 3 years. Must hold certification and be in eAYSO as a documented Referee. Persons transferring or new to the region may apply for a waiver if proof of training is provided. Speak with the Chief Referee for waiver.
- Region Staff or Board Member 10 points
Must be a registered staff or board member. Must be entered into eAYSO. Must have Safe Haven certification for current year.

Game Points – points awarded after each game

- All Players present for game 1pts (x12) (12 max)
All Players are present for at least 3 quarters of game and are in full uniform
- All Players present for weekly practice 1pts (x12) (12 max)
All Players are present for weekly practice
- Provide Referee for game 5pts (X 12) (60 max)
Every game that a certified referee is on the center of the pitch AND is scheduled AND turns in the game cards, will be awarded the full points. Referee must be trained, certified and in uniform to receive the points

Provide Assistant Referee and Linesman for the game 5pts per ref (X12) (120 max)
Assistant Referees (AR) in uniform may be awarded 2 points per game. Assistant Referee must be trained, certified and in uniform to receive the points

Field Set up/Clean Up 1 (X12) (12 max)
These points can be earned by having the goals set up each week in a timely fashion. Games are started on time. This applies mostly to the home team that sets up the field each week. Points can also be earned if all trash is picked up at the end of the day. These points are awarded each week, Obviously, if the first game of the day is delayed, then all other games are delayed and the later teams will not be penalized. Any reports to the Board of messy fields or broken equipment will cause points to be removed from the team.

Player volunteers as a VIP Buddy 2pts (x12) (24 max per player)
In promoting the concept that everyone plays the region now has a VIP league (Very Important Player) that allows special needs players learn and enjoy the game of soccer. These VIP players need buddies to help them every week. 2 pts will be awarded to any player that volunteers to help as a VIP buddy each week.

Deductions from Points

Game win >10 goals -10 points per game

Teams winning by 10 goals are not following the basic AYSO philosophy of safe, fair and fun.

Exceptions to this point loss will be handled on a case by case basis. If a team has 5-10 different players, each scoring 1 goal, then a point may still be awarded at the discretion of the region's board of directors.

Player Yellow card -10 points per incident
Players receiving a yellow card during a game are not showing good sportsmanship and living up to the AYSO philosophies of safe, fair and fun.

Player Red card -25 points per incident
Players receiving a red card during a game are not showing good sportsmanship and living up to the AYSO philosophies of safe, fair and fun. Any player receiving a red card may also not be awarded a sportsmanship award even if their team has earned it, this decision will be left to the sole discretion of the board.

Deductions made by the Region's Board of Directors

– Amount of points to be deducted will be determined by a vote of the Region's Board of Directors

Coach Gamesmanship

These points are related to coach and assistant behavior during the match. Coaching is only to be: positive, instructional and encouraging (PIE). Any behavior above and beyond such will not be tolerated. Any comments, behavior or actions towards the referee, opposing players, teams, or coaches will mean points will be deducted.

Parent Gamesmanship

These points are related to parent behavior towards the referee, opposing players, teams, or coaches. Any comments, behavior or actions towards the referee, opposing players, teams, or coaches will mean points will be deducted.
